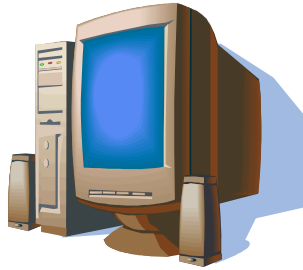
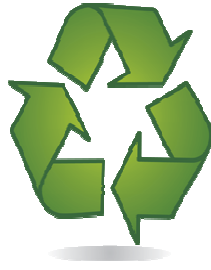

Office and Household Electronics:

- Air Cleaners
- Answering Machines
- Blenders
- Calculators
- Cellular Phones
- Copiers
- Scanners
- DVD Players
- Fax Machines
- Gaming Units
- IPODS, MP3 Players
- Radios, CD Players
- Telephones
- Televisions
- Various Media (floppy disks, cd's, memory sticks.)

#### Computer Components and Accessories:

- APC Battery Back-ups
- Circuit Boards
- Docking Stations
- Keyboards & Mice
- Laptops, MAC's, PC's
- Modems
- Monitors
- PDA's (Blackberrys, Palm Pilots, iPhones)
- Speakers
- Towers

There will be a \$5 fee for each computer monitor and a \$10 fee for each T.V. Monitor that residents will have to pay. All other electronic devices are free! (Unwanted Medication and Household Hazardous Waste Drop Off Free!)

Electronic Devices are being collected by a Reputable Electronic Recycling Company that has a zero landfill, and hard drive destruction policy!

#### Home :

- oil-based paint
- wood stain
- cleaning products
- paint thinner
- adhesives
- glues

#### Yard, Garden & Garage:

- weed killer
- fertilizer
- pest poisons
- pool chemicals
- antifreeze
- deck sealer
- auto fluids

#### Miscellaneous:

- fluorescent light bulbs & cfl's
  - mercury thermometers
  - batteries (not auto)
  - aerosol cans
