Send letter plus administration fees to the lighting districts who are failing to pay for the street lights. If a 3<sup>rd</sup> letter is sent, the attorney will be contacted and PCI will issue no permits until the bill is paid. Attorney fees will also be added to the payment. Motion carried.
2. Don Sebright moved and Randy Boyles seconded to send the blight letter to PCI. Motion carried
3. Sheila Buckleitner moved and Betty Brower seconded to approve the 2010 Salem Township Meeting Dates. Motion carried.
4. Meth Diversion Program Funding failed to receive support.
